Maths	Summer 1	Revision During the first half term, as the children will be completing their KS1 SAT's, lessons will focus on mental arithmetic skills and reasoning skills. Science	Summer 1	Our first topic is mini worlds. During this topic, the children will learn about mini beasts and they will observe the life cycle of a butterfly. 	Summer 2	Our first topic is Young Gardeners, during which the children will learn about plants including labelling, growing and caring for them.	Spiritual- Focusing on the change in seasons, wondering about different seasons and how this affects the growth of plants during each period.
ICT	Summer 1	The children will study how programmes work.	Social- Working in pairs to use computer programmes. Taking turns and looking after equipment. Moral- Showing respect to each other and resources.
